

BOVINA ISD BOND

MAY 4, 2024



The Board of Trustees approved calling a bond election for May 4, 2024. The \$15,000,000 bond package, if approved by the voters, will provide funds for facility improvements and enhanced safety measures for students.

Voters will have the option to vote for or against each proposition separately. Proposition A and B can have the same "for" or "against" vote, or different votes for each proposition may be selected.

PROPOSITION A \$8,000,000

Restroom Renovations to Comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

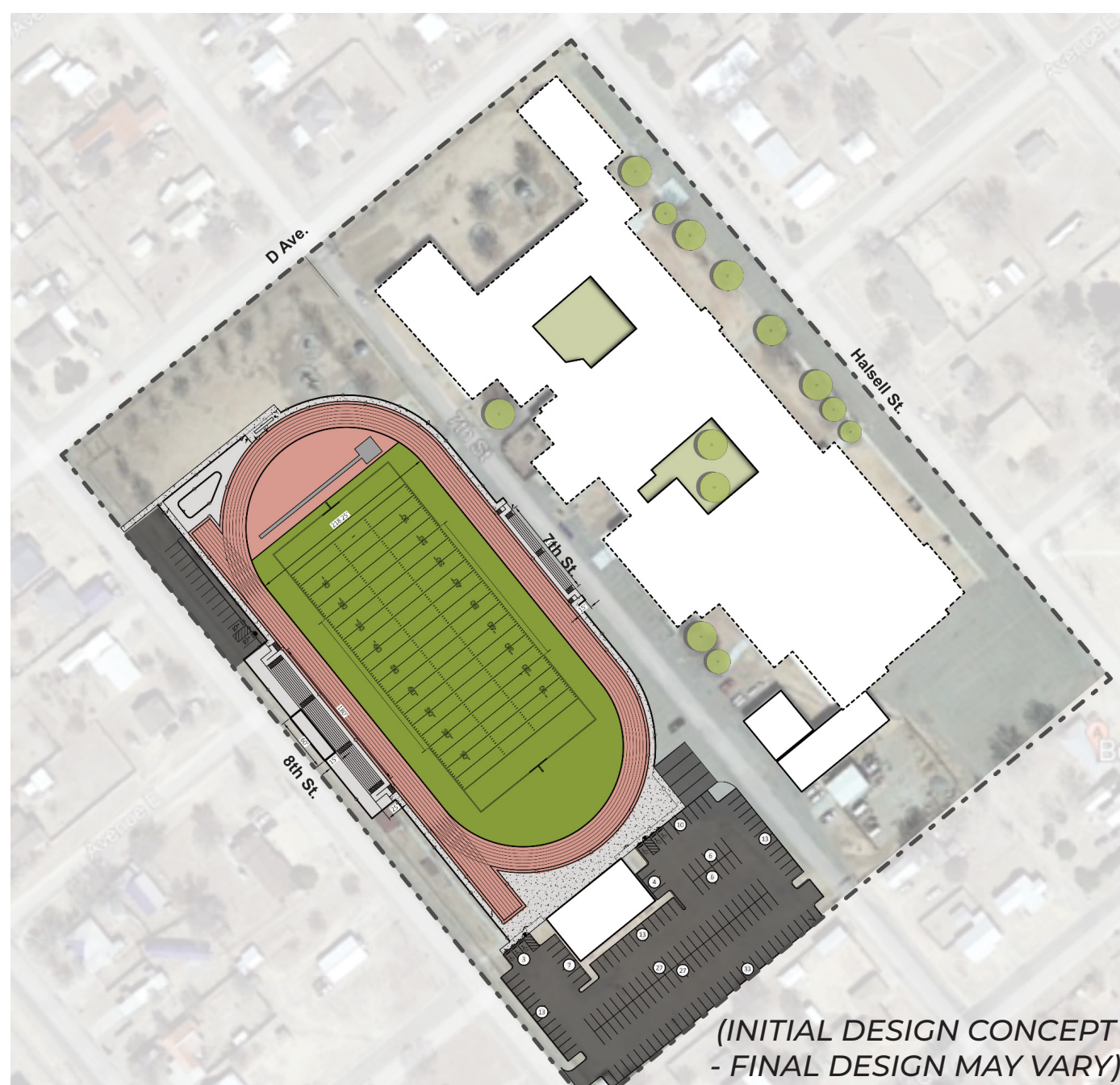
- Provides accessibility for all abilities
- Key considerations:
 - Grab bars near toilets and sinks
 - Ample space for wheelchair maneuverability
 - Proper door width for wheelchair access
 - Lowering sinks and mirrors to accessible heights

PROPOSITION B \$7,000,000



Relocate Track and Field to the main campus

- 7 lane track
- Grass field
- 1200 (18") home side seats
- 800 (18") visitor side seats
- New field lighting
- New parking on north and south ends of new track

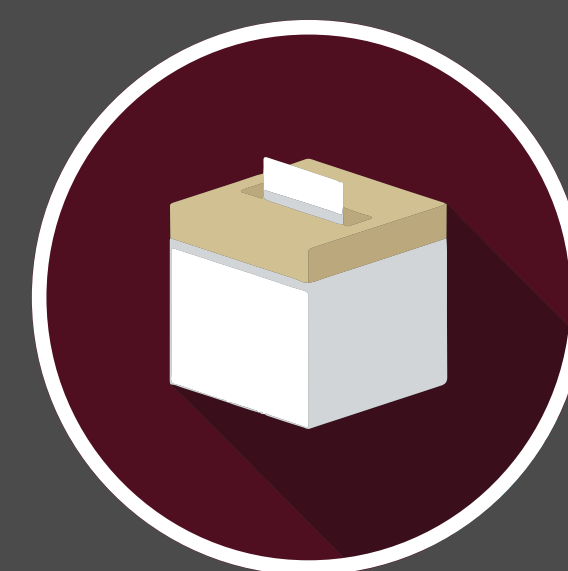

By state law, the dollar amount of school taxes imposed on the residence homestead of a person 65 years of age or older cannot be increased above the amount paid in the first year after the person turned 65, regardless of changes in tax rate or property value unless significant improvements are made to the home.

Contact Parmer County Appraisal District to file for a homestead and/or Over 65 exemption.
