Bovina students' well-being and success remains the top priority of Bovina ISD. Our commitment includes ensuring children can access nutritious food at school.

Starting December 1, Bovina ISD is operating the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) This federal nutrition program allows us to serve nutritious meals in our community to children 18 years old and younger at no cost to the child. All Bovina ISD students can receive daily meals whether they are learning in person or remotely. SFSP is a U.S. Department of Agriculture nutrition program administered in the Lone Star State by the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA).

Any meal charges incurred before December 1 will be the responsibility of the parent. Meals at no cost will begin December 1 and extend through June 30.

Bovina ISD is partnering with TDA to serve meals across Texas. Families are encouraged to use these three tools to find a meal site anywhere in the state:
